A brief description of our growing practices

The herb plantings at Friends of the Trees Botanicals are agroforestry systems which include a wide diversity of trees, shrubs, hedgerows, medicinal herbs, berries, vegetables and culinary herbs. My herb plantings have been organic certified on and off over the years. My current main planting is leased from a long-time, certified organic grower. I have been farming organically since 1972 and am well known in the regional organic movement. My botanicals are not certified organic in 2010, but they are grown without the use of chemical fertilizers or pesticides. We use cultural practices and natural fertilizers to build soil. Our goal is healthy plants, a healthy ecosystem and good crops.
