Windbreak & Yard Trees

What do the numbers mean?

1-0, 2-3' means 1-year old seedlings, 2 to 3 feet high.

2-1, 12-18" means a seedling that grew 2 years in one spot and then was transplanted for an additional year, 12 to 18 inches high.
